

RESOLUTION NO. 201

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, ADOPTING A SIX-YEAR TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR THE YEARS 2002-2007 AND DIRECTING THE SAME TO BE FILED WITH THE STATE SECRETARY OF TRANSPORTATION AND THE TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT BOARD.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the requirements of Chapters 35.77 and 47.26 RCW, the City Council of the City of Woodinville has previously adopted a Comprehensive Street Program, including an arterial street construction program, and has thereafter periodically modified said Comprehensive Street Program by resolution, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed the work accomplished under the Program, determined current and future City street and arterial needs and based upon these findings, has prepared a Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program for the ensuing six (6) calendar years, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing has been held on the Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program as required by RCW 35.77.010, and

WHEREAS, the TIP has been updated for 2002-2007 in accordance with the State requirements, **NOW THEREFORE**,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Program Adopted. The Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program for the City of Woodinville, as revised and extended for the ensuing six (6) calendar years (2002-2007), a copy of which is attached hereto as Attachment A and incorporated herein by this reference as if fully set forth, which Program sets forth the project location, type of improvement and the estimated cost thereof, is hereby adopted and approved.

Section 2. Filing of Program. Pursuant to Chapter 35.77 RCW, within 30 days of the adoption of this resolution the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to file a copy of this resolution, together with Attachment A attached hereto, with the Secretary of Transportation and a copy with the Transportation Improvement Board for the State of Washington.
