WHEREAS, the Woodinville City Council wishes to adopt language relating to clarifying the intentions of Councilmembers interested in serving as Mayor or Deputy Mayor; and

WHEREAS, the City Council will review Council Procedures in January 2002; and

WHEREAS, the City Council will consider amending the Council Procedures in January 2002 to include language declaring the interests of a Councilmembers to serve as Mayor or Deputy Mayor;

Declaration of Interest.


