

RESOLUTION NO. 208

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON SUPPORTING THE PROPOSED NORTSHORE PARKS & RECREATION SERVICE AREA (PRSA) BOND ISSUE.

WHEREAS, the Northshore PRSA was formed in 1988 to establish a funding mechanism to construct the Northshore Senior Center; and

WHEREAS, the Northshore PRSA Board voted on August 16, 2001 to place a \$3,895,000 bond issue on the November 6, 2001 election ballot for the construction of the Northshore Adult Day Center; and

WHEREAS, the Northshore Senior Center has provided exceptional services to the Northshore senior citizen community; and

WHEREAS, the projected number of people expected to benefit from the programs and services of the Northshore Adult Day Center is approximately 6,000 and the numbers will increase as programs develop and the population continues to expand; and

WHEREAS, the facility will house an adult day health center, serving adults aged 21 to 100 plus years with a wide range of cognitive, physical and developmental disabilities and will also include health and wellness programs geared to more independent participants through the Senior Wellness Program, as well as transportation services for seniors and disabled adults; and

WHEREAS, by situating the new Adult Day Center across the street from the existing senior center, adult day center participants will be able to enjoy special events, classes and activities that will widen their range of choices and enrich their lives; and

WHEREAS, the goal is to integrate adults in the Northshore Service Area to all levels of function and ability into the life of the Northshore Senior Center and our community.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Woodinville supports the Northshore Adult Day Center bond issue to acquire land and construct an adult day center.
