WHEREAS, the City Council desires to have a Plan that will control system costs and continue to keep disposal rates stable and low; and


WHEREAS, the King County 2001 Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan (Plan) is necessary to accomplish this need;

The City of Woodinville supports the adoption of the King County 2001 Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan as published in November 2001.


