WHEREAS, the Finance Committee has recommended that the fees and charges were acceptable for 2002,





*CF: **Consultant fees:** In addition to the application fee, the applicant shall submit a deposit for the costs of professional consultants hired by the City to review and inspect the applicant's proposal. These professional services may include, but shall not be limited to, engineering, legal, planning, environmental review, financial and accounting. The applicant will be required to deposit an additional amount with the City if the initial deposit is not sufficient to cover all the costs of retaining professional consultants. Any amount of the deposit not required for Consultant Fees will be refunded.

Single-family: Single-family residential fee applies to applicants that meet the following criteria:

- a) The proposed type of action will not change the existing and/or proposed single-family or duplex use of the property; and,
- b) The property is zoned R-1, R-4, R-6 or R-8, and developed with a single-family or duplex residence; or
- c) The property includes a single-family residential dwelling or duplexes; or
- d) A building permit for a single-family residence has been applied for on the property.

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The most current Building Valuation Data, as published in the International Conference of Building Officials Building Standards, shall be used to calculate building valuation. The modifier for the City of Woodinville is 100%.

BUILDING VALUATION DATA

At the request of numerous building officials, *Building Standards*™ offers the following building valuation data representing average costs for most buildings. Because residential buildings are the most common for many cities, two general classes are considered for these, one for "average" construction and the other for "good." Adjustments should be made for special architectural or structural features and the location of the project. Higher or lower unit costs may often result.

The unit costs are intended to comply with the definition of "valuation" in Section 223 of the 1997 *Uniform Building Code*™ and thus include architectural, structural, electrical, plumbing and mechanical work, except as specifically listed below. The unit costs also include the contractor's profit, which should not be omitted.

The determination of plan check fees for projects reviewed by the International Conference of Building Officials will be based on valuation computed from these figures, which were established in April 2001.
