

**Resolution No. 229**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF  
WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, ADOPTING  
THE SKATE/BMX PARK MASTER PLAN.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Woodinville has a goal of meeting park, recreation, and open space needs for the Woodinville Parks and Recreation Service Area; and

**WHEREAS**, the policies supporting this goal call for the City to provide parks and open spaces that support activities that can be enjoyed by all ages interests; and

**WHEREAS**, the policies supporting this goal also call for the City to purchase and protect environmentally sensitive areas to conserve habitat for endangered species, and provide education and interpretive areas to increase public awareness and protection of those species; and

**WHEREAS**, the Woodinville Parks and Recreation Commission has completed a comprehensive public outreach effort to study the potential future uses of an 18 acre site located at 136<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE and NE 195<sup>th</sup> Street, and has gathered information and conducted analysis of the public desires for future uses of the property; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has overseen the creation of a plan which reflects public opinion, incorporates the recommendations of the Parks and Recreation Commission, and presents conceptual architectural plans that can guide the development of the site; and

**WHEREAS**, the City intends to use the plan as a guide to future phasing and implementation in order to invite, inspire, and engage all Woodinville citizens in the use of this outstanding facility;

**NOW, THEREFORE,**

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, DOES  
RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Adoption of the Plan. The City Council hereby adopts the Skate/BMX Park Master Plan, as set forth on Attachment A.
