

## RESOLUTION NO. 231

### A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, ACCEPTING THE DEDICATION OF A PORTION OF 124<sup>th</sup> AVENUE NE AS A PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY.

**WHEREAS**, it is the role of the City Council to accept real property into the City's inventory of public right-of-way; and

**WHEREAS**, the right-of-way width of 124<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE will be consistent with the roadway classification as identified in the City's Comprehensive Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, Ahmet Ozegovic is developing a piece of real property within the City of Bothell's city limits which abuts the City of Woodinville's westerly city limits along 124th Avenue NE; and

**WHEREAS**, Ahmet Ozegovic is dedicating the right-of-way along 124th Avenue NE to the City of Woodinville as part of City of Bothell's requirement for the Applicant's preliminary plat approval; and **NOW, THEREFORE**,

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**


1. Intent – To provide for the public frontage improvements and right-of-way along 124<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE.
2. Right-of-way Dedication – The right-of-way in this dedication consists of that portion of land as shown in the legal description on Exhibit A.



A PORTION OF THE SOUTH 102 FEET OF THE NORTH 132 FEET OF THE WEST 469.47 FEET OF THE 499.47 FEET OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 16, TOWNSHIP 26 NORTH, RANGE 5 EAST, W.M., IN KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON; TOGETHER WITH THE NORTH 30.00 FEET OF THE EAST 499.47 FEET, AS MEASURED AT RIGHT ANGLES, OF THE NORTH HALF OF THE NORTH HALF OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SAID SECTION 16; EXCEPT THE EAST 30.00 FEET THEREOF FOR ROAD (124<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE NORTHEAST) DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

THENCE SOUTH 03°34'23" WEST, ALONG SAID WEST LINE, 132.15 FEET TO THE SOUTH LINE OF SAID SOUTH 102 FEET THEREOF;  
THENCE NORTH 89°07'35" WEST, ALONG SAID SOUTH LINE, 7.00 FEET;  
THENCE NORTH 03°34'23" EAST 132.15 FEET TO THE NORTH LINE OF SAID NORTHWEST QUARTER;  
THENCE SOUTH 89°07'35" EAST, ALONG SAID NORTH LINE, 7.00 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING.
