

Resolution No. 238

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, EXPRESSING OPPOSITION TO INITIATIVE 776.

WHEREAS, Initiative 776 proposes to reduce license fees to \$30, which would have significant impacts on the ability of Sound Transit to carry out its mandates; and

WHEREAS, the passage of Initiative 776 would also reduce funding for street maintenance in the City of Woodinville; and

WHEREAS, the passage of Initiative 776 would also reduce funding for the Washington State Patrol from loss of licensing fees for light trucks; and

WHEREAS, Initiative 776 would be contrary to the intent of the voters who established the Regional Transit Authority and funding for Sound Transit; and


WHEREAS, the passage of Initiative 776 would result in direct and indirect service impacts to Woodinville citizens in the vital area of transportation;
