
WHEREAS, Deputy Mayor Bogue, as a member of the Finance Committee, carefully considered the many fiscal issues that surfaced during her tenure; and

WHEREAS, Deputy Mayor Bogue knew her co-workers at City Hall quite well and made her famous sour cream fudge when it was desperately needed;


