

**RESOLUTION NO. 266**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF  
WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON,  
SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING DATE  
TO CONSIDER VACATION OF  
RIGHT-OF-WAY ON NE 175<sup>th</sup> STREET**

**WHEREAS**, a petition signed by the owner of more than two thirds of the property abutting upon properties dedicated for street purposes, located in the City of Woodinville, Washington, being a portion of NE 175<sup>th</sup> Street; with the full legal description as described on Attachment 'A' and shown on Attachment 'B' attached hereto and incorporated in full by this reference, was filed with the Woodinville City Clerk for the right-of-way vacation of the above described properties and who has returned a certification of sufficiency, and

**Location:**

That portion of NE 175<sup>th</sup> Street (not open) lying northerly of Block 2, Plat of Town of Woodinville.

**Legal Description:**

That portion of NE 175<sup>th</sup> Street (not open) bounded on the north by the north line of the southeast quarter of Section 9, Township 26N, Range 5E, Willamette Meridian, bounded on the west by the east right-of-way margin of NE 173<sup>rd</sup> Place, bounded on the east by the west right-of-way margin of NE Woodinville Road, and bounded on the south by the north line of Block 2 per Plat of Town of Woodinville, Volume 6, Page 22 records of King County, Washington.

Containing 5000 square feet or 0.11 acres more or less.
