

## RESOLUTION NO. 275

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE,  
WASHINGTON, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 265, ESTABLISHING REVISED FIRE  
CODE PERMIT FEES.**

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**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to establish fees and charges for services by resolution, and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council had directed the Finance Committee to review the fees and charges with the Departments proposing the fees and charges, and

**WHEREAS**, the adoption of the International Fire Code requires the fees to match the operational requirements of the International Fire Code, and

**WHEREAS**, the Finance Committee has reviewed the proposed fees and found them acceptable,

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE,  
WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** Effective July 1, 2004, the Woodinville City Council hereby repeals the Woodinville Fire and Life Safety District Annual Uniform Fire Code Permit Fees established by Resolution No. 265.

**Section 2.** Effective July 1, 2004, the Woodinville City Council hereby adopts the Woodinville Fire and Life Safety District Annual Uniform Fire Code Permit Fees as set forth in Attachment A of this resolution for use, administration and enforcing the International Fire Code established by Ordinance No. 366.

**Section 3. Severability/Savings.** If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Resolution or any resolution adopted or amended hereby, should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution.
