

RESOLUTION NO. 278

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE INCLUSION OF NON-REGULAR EMPLOYEES IN THE CITY'S COMMUTE TRIP REDUCTION PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, increasing motor vehicle traffic has created heavy congestion on the City's roadway network; and

WHEREAS, Washington State under RCW 70.94 requires public agencies to adopt Commute Trip Reduction Programs to address increased traffic congestion; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted through Ordinance No. 195 a Commute Trip Reduction Program, implementing measures required by RCW 70.94; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wants to encourage all City employees, regular and non-regular, to use trip reducing measures; and

WHEREAS, the City's current Commute Trip Reduction Program does not include non-regular employees; **NOW, THEREFORE**,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. That a regular or non-regular paid City employee, shall be considered an "affected employee" under the City's Commute Trip Reduction Program and shall be eligible for all programs under this Program to encourage the use of methods to reduce motor vehicle traffic coming to and leaving their regular hours of work.
