RESOLUTION NO. 280

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, REJECTING ALL CONSTRUCTION BIDS FOR THE BOTTLENECK RELIEF PROJECT PHASE TWO – SR 202/NE 177TH PL (NORTH LEG WIDENING) AND SOUND TRANSIT FLYER STOPS.

WHEREAS, the City has an identified Capital Improvement project for the widening, other traffic, and pedestrian improvements along SR 202 between SR 522 and Little Bear Creek; and

WHEREAS, Sound Transit (ST) has partnered with the City to provide for Flyer Stops along the west side of the SR 522 ramps; and

WHEREAS, on 12 August 2004, the City formally opened construction bids for the Bottleneck Relief Project Phase Two – SR 202/NE 177th PL (North Leg Widening) and ST Flyer Stops; and

WHEREAS, all bids exceeded the approved budget by over 50%; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 35.23.352(1), the City desires to reject all bids received for said project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council rejected said bids by motion at the August 16, 2004 regular Council Meeting; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Rejection of All Bids. The City Council hereby rejects all bids received for the Bottleneck Relief Project Phase Two – SR 202/NE 177th PL (North Leg Widening) and ST Flyer Stops.
