

## RESOLUTION NO. 283

### A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, TO ADOPT THE REGIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN OF KING COUNTY.

**Whereas**, the City of Woodinville is vulnerable to the human and economic costs of natural, technological and societal disasters, and

**Whereas**, the Woodinville City Council recognizes the importance of reducing or eliminating those vulnerabilities for the public health, safety and welfare of the community, and

**Whereas**, the City of Woodinville has been an active participant in the Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan of the King County Task Force, which has established a comprehensive, coordinated planning process to eliminate or decrease hazardous risks; and

**Whereas**, City of Woodinville representatives and staff have identified, justified and prioritized proposed projects and programs needed to mitigate the vulnerabilities of the City of Woodinville to the impacts of future disasters, and

**Whereas**, these proposed projects and programs have been incorporated into the Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan that has been prepared and issued for consideration and implementation by the communities of King County, Washington,

**Whereas**, on June 9, 2004, the Federal Emergency Management Agency accepted the Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan for King County, Washington:

#### THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1:** The Woodinville City Council hereby approves its designated portion of the Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan.

**Section 2:** The agency personnel of the City of Woodinville are requested and instructed to pursue available funding opportunities for implementation of the proposals designated herein.


**Section 3:** The City of Woodinville will, upon receipt of such funding or other necessary resources, seek to implement the proposals contained in its section of the strategy.

**Section 4:** The City of Woodinville will continue to participate in the future updating and expansion of the Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan.


