

RESOLUTION NO. 288

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, CREATING A LAND USE COMMITTEE, PROVIDING FOR THE SELECTION OF LAND USE COMMITTEE MEMBERS, AND SETTING FORTH THEIR DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES.

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to have a Land Use Committee to assist with the review and to provide recommendations for complex policy issues regarding comprehensive planning and land use; and

WHEREAS, on January 3, 2005, the City Council unanimously supported the creation of a Land Use Committee; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to formalize the creation of the Land Use Committee:

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Woodinville, Washington, as follows:

Section 1. Land Use Committee Created. There is hereby created a Land Use Committee, consisting of three Councilmembers, to be a recommending body to the City Council in regards to comprehensive planning and land use matters of the City.

Section 2. Committee Structure. The Committee shall consist of three Councilmembers, appointed by the Mayor and affirmed by the City Council. Support staff shall include the Community Development Director or designee and the City Manager. Committee meetings are open to the public, and members of the Planning Commission may attend.

Section 3. Term of Office. The term of the three Councilmembers shall be two years. New appointments shall be made in January of odd numbered years.

Section 4. Meetings. The Land Use Committee shall meet every month with the option of canceling any meeting due to lack of agenda items. One additional meeting per month may be added by the Committee as determined by the Committee members.

Section 5. Responsibilities. The Land Use Committee shall be a recommending body to the City Council on policies relating to the following matters:

- a. Comprehensive plan, sub-area plans, land use master plans.
- b. Ordinances pertaining to land use regulations.
- c. Strategic citywide plans or policy planning documents.
- d. Review of items referred by the City Council.
- e. City items deemed appropriate by the Land Use Committee.
