

RESOLUTION NO. 308

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 286, ESTABLISHING REVISED FIRE CODE PERMIT FEES AND RECREATION CHARGES.

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to establish fees and charges for services by resolution, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has supported an annual review of fees and charges to ensure that the fees and charges are appropriate for the service provided, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has directed the Finance Committee to review the fees and charges with the departments proposing the fees and charges, and

WHEREAS, the costs of providing Fire Code permit have, and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Departments have requested minor changes to existing fees for programs and services, and

WHEREAS, the Finance Committee has reviewed the proposed fees and found them acceptable,

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE,
WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Effective January 1, 2006, the Woodinville City Council hereby repeals the Woodinville Fire and Life Safety District Annual International Fire Code Permit Fees established by Resolution No. 286.

Section 2. Effective January 1, 2006, the Woodinville City Council hereby repeals the Woodinville Park and Recreation Fees established by Resolution No. 286.

Section 3. Effective January 1, 2006, the Woodinville City Council hereby adopts the Woodinville Fire and Life Safety District Annual International Fire Code Permit Fees as set forth in Attachment A of this resolution for use, administration and enforcing the International Fire Code established by Ordinance No. 366.

Section 4. Effective January 1, 2007, the Woodinville City Council hereby adopts the Woodinville Fire and Life Safety District Annual International Fire Code Permit Fees as set forth in Attachment A of this resolution for use, administration and enforcing the International Fire Code established by Ordinance No. 366, using a cost-of-living adjustment as defined in the resolution, for determining fees to be effective on January 1, 2007.

Section 5. Effective January 1, 2006, the Woodinville City Council hereby adopts the Woodinville Park and Recreation fees as set forth in Attachment A of this resolution.

Section 6. Severability/Savings. If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Resolution or any resolution adopted or amended hereby, should be held to be invalid or

unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution.
