**A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING AND ACKNOWLEDGING
ROBERT R. MILLER AS COUNCILMEMBER OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE**

WHEREAS, Robert R. Miller was elected in November of 1992 to serve on the Interim City Council and re-elected in November of 1993; November 1997; and again in 2001; and

WHEREAS, Councilmember Miller served as Deputy Mayor from November 1991-1995 and Mayor January 1996-1997; and

WHEREAS, Councilmember Miller was a lead player in new city services and programs including the City's Traveler's Information Radio Station, and the Spirit of Woodinville citizen/business recognition program; and.

WHEREAS, Councilmember Miller supported major capital improvement projects including Wilmot Gateway Park, Rotary Community Park, Woodinville Community Center, 133rd Avenue Grid Road and 136th Avenue rebuild, channelization and roundabout; and

WHEREAS, Councilmember Miller served as a member on the Fire District Joint Policy Board and the Northshore Parks & Recreation Service Area Board; and

WHEREAS, Councilmember Miller unofficially established the "Atomic Fireball" as the City's "official" candy; and

WHEREAS, Councilmember Miller's commitment to the Woodinville community is reflected through his service on the Board of Commissioners, Woodinville Fire and Life Safety District; and

WHEREAS, Councilmember Miller's passion for public safety is reflected in his career with the Seattle Police Department and extended into his service as is also a Seattle Reserve Police Officer.


