

## RESOLUTION NO. 311

### A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, ESTABLISHING SURFACE WATER MANAGEMENT FEES FOR THE YEAR 2006.

**WHEREAS**, the City Council established a storm and surface water utility by the adoption of Ordinance No. 26 on 8 March 1993; and

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 26 adopted the storm and surface water management fees that were established by King County in 1992; and

**WHEREAS**, the Surface Water Management (SWM) fee rate schedule did not include an inflation or growth rate factor; and

**WHEREAS**, the fees have not changed from those established by Ordinance No. 26; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 313 on 14 January 2002 allowing the SWM fees to be amended by resolution of the City Council; and

**WHEREAS**, in 2004 operational costs for the SWM matched revenues; and

**WHEREAS**, in 2005 operational costs for the SWM exceeded revenues and reserves were required to balance the budget; and

**WHEREAS**, during the 12 December 2005 Council meeting, the Council reviewed several alternatives to address how to continue to balance the SWM budget; and

**WHEREAS**, Council decided to establish a one time 2.5 percent increase to the SWM fees for implementation in 2006; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has directed the Public Works staff to review the SWM fees upon the adoption of the SWM Comprehensive Plan in 2006; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE,  
WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Effective immediately, the fees attached as Exhibit A are hereby adopted by this reference.

Section 2. Severability/Savings. If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Resolution or any resolution adopted or amended hereby, should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution.

### Surface Water Management Fee Schedule For 2006 Implementation

Rate Category	Percent Impervious Surface	Annual Service Charge (\$)
<b>1) Residential: single-family home</b>	<b>NA</b>	<b>87.15/parcel</b>
<b>2) Very Light</b>	<b>≤ 10%</b>	<b>87.15/parcel</b>
<b>3) Light</b>	<b>More than 10%, ≤ 20%</b>	<b>203.36/acre</b>
<b>4) Moderate</b>	<b>More than 20%, ≤ 45%</b>	<b>421.25/acre</b>
<b>5) Moderate Heavy</b>	<b>More than 45%, ≤ 65%</b>	<b>813.44/acre</b>
<b>6) Heavy</b>	<b>More than 65%, ≤ 85%</b>	<b>1,031.31/acre</b>
<b>7) Very Heavy</b>	<b>More than 85%, ≤ 100%</b>	<b>1,350.89/acre</b>
