

RÉSOLUTION NO. 315

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, SUPPORTING THE NORTHSHORE SCHOOL DISTRICT PROPOSITIONS 1, 2, & 3, LEVIES AND CAPITAL PROJECTS BOND, TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE VOTERS ON FEBRUARY 7, 2006.

WHEREAS, the Northshore School District is submitting three measures to the voters in February of 2006; and

WHEREAS, the City of Woodinville held a public hearing on January 9, 2006 to receive public testimony relating to the Northshore School District Levy and Bond Measures, and

WHEREAS, Proposition 1, the Renewal Educational Maintenance and Operations Levy will allow the School District to maintain and enhance current instruction, curriculum and class size; Proposition 2, the Renewal Technology Capital Projects Levy will allow the district to continue its commitment to technology in the classroom; and Proposition 3, the General Obligation Bonds will enable the School District to modernize and make needed renovations to existing structures and fields.



Section 1. The Woodinville City Council hereby formally supports the following Northshore School District's Levy and Bond Measure with respect to the February 7, 2006 ballot:

- Proposition 1: Renewal Educational Maintenance & Operations Levy
- Proposition 2: Renewal Technology Capital Projects Levy
- Proposition 3: General Obligation Bonds
