

RESOLUTION NO. 322

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, ESTABLISHING FEES AND CHARGES FOR RESIDENTIAL MAILBOX INSTALLATION WITHIN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY.

WHEREAS, mail theft is a community concern; and

WHEREAS, mail theft requires many hours of police resources to respond to each reported incident; and

WHEREAS, whereas locking mailboxes are an effective deterrent to this type of crime; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to promote the installation of locking mailboxes for the protection of postal deliveries to its community; and

WHEREAS, the City Council recognizes that protection is a benefit to the public good; and

WHEREAS, a reduction in this crime frees up valuable police resources to provide other needed services; and

WHEREAS, mailboxes are typically located within the public right-of-way and under City code require a permit to perform installation of a new mailbox; and

WHEREAS, to be in compliance with the current City right-of-way permit requirements, a fee is required; and

WHEREAS, the City Council had directed that the right-of-way permit fee for mailbox installation be established at \$1 per permit; and

WHEREAS, this requires the establishment of this fee by resolution;


NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Effective immediately, the fees and charges attached as Exhibit A are hereby adopted by this reference.

Section 2. Severability/Savings. If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Resolution or any resolution adopted or amended hereby, should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or

unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution.
