

RESOLUTION NO. 324

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR FUNDING ASSISTANCE FOR A WASHINGTON WILDLIFE AND RECREATION PROGRAM (WWRP) PROJECT TO THE INTERAGENCY COMMITTEE FOR OUTDOOR RECREATION (IAC) AS PROVIDED IN CHAPTER 79A.15 RCW, ACQUISITION OF HABITAT CONSERVATION AND OUTDOOR RECREATION LANDS FOR DEVELOPMENT OF THE CIVIC SPORTSFIELDS PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of Woodinville has approved its Comprehensive Plan and Parks Recreation and Open Space Plan which document the need for this project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Woodinville has approved a Civic Center Master Plan that describes the basic components of the Civic Campus including the preservation and improvements of the sports fields; and

WHEREAS, the City of Woodinville has conducted numerous public outreach meetings, notices, news releases, and special events which have resulted in the design of a field improvements project that meets the needs of current and future citizens and provides a sense of community and a place for cultural and recreation activities; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of WWRP, state funding assistance is requested to aid in financing the cost of facility development; and

WHEREAS, the City considers it in the best public interest to complete the facility development project described in the application;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager be authorized to make formal application to IAC for funding assistance;

Section 2. Any fund assistance received be used for implementation of the project referenced above;

Section 3. The City hereby certifies that its share of project funding will be derived from Park Impact Funds, Real Estate Excise Tax Revenues, Admission Tax Revenues, Donations, or Sponsorships;

Section 4. The City acknowledges that any facility developed with IAC financial aid must be placed in use as an outdoor recreation facility and be retained in such use in perpetuity unless otherwise provided and agreed to by the City and IAC;

Section 5. This resolution becomes part of a formal application to IAC;
and

Section 6. The City can substantiate that it has provided appropriate opportunity for public comment on this application.

Section 7. Severability/Savings. If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Resolution or any resolution adopted or amended hereby, should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution.
