

RESOLUTION NO. 329

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON,
EXPRESSING OPPOSITION TO INITIATIVE 933.**

WHEREAS, Initiative 933 would require compensation when government regulation damages the use or value of private property, would forbid regulations that prohibit existing legal uses of private property, and would provide exceptions or payments; and

WHEREAS, the passage of Initiative 933 would undermine local land use decisions; and

WHEREAS, Initiative 933 would require payments to aggrieved property owners; and

WHEREAS, the City of Woodinville has not anticipated the use of City revenue for payments to property owners; and

WHEREAS, the passage of Initiative 933 could result in a shifting of revenue pledged to services or capital projects;

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**


That the City Council, having held a public hearing on October 16, 2006 during which all points of view were given an opportunity to speak, OPPOSES Initiative 933.
