

RESOLUTION NO. 345

A RESOLUTION OF THE WOODINVILLE CITY COUNCIL, AMENDING RESOLUTION 308, ESTABLISHING REVISED FIRE CODE PERMIT FEES AND PARK AND RECREATION FEES AND ADOPTING NEW FEES FOR GIS AND PUBLIC RECORDS SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to establish fees and charges for services by resolution, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has supported an bi-annual review of fees and charges to ensure that the fees and charges are appropriate for the service provided, and

WHEREAS, the costs of providing Fire Code permits have risen, and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Departments have requested minor changes to existing fees for programs and services, and

WHEREAS, additional fees have been recommended for providing GIS and Public Records services, and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Effective January 1, 2008, the Woodinville City Council hereby repeals the Woodinville Fire and Life Safety District Annual International Fire Code Permit fees established by Resolution No. 308.

Section 2. Effective January 1, 2008, the Woodinville City Council hereby adopts the Woodinville Fire and Life Safety District Annual International Fire Code Permit fees as set forth in Attachments 2 & 3 of this resolution for use, administration and enforcing the International Fire Code established by Ordinance No. 444.

Section 3. Effective January 1, 2009, the Woodinville City Council hereby adopts the Woodinville Fire and Life Safety District Annual International Fire Code Permit fees as set forth in Attachments 2 & 3 of this resolution for use, administration and enforcing the International Fire Code established by Ordinance No. 444, using a cost-of-living adjustment as defined in the resolution, for determining fees to be effective on January 1, 2009.

Section 4. Effective January 1, 2008, the Woodinville City Council hereby amends the Park and Recreation fees established by Resolution No. 308.

Section 5. Effective January 1, 2008, the Woodinville City Council hereby adopts the Park and Recreation fees as set forth in Attachments 4 of this resolution.

Section 6. Effective January 1, 2008, the Woodinville City Council hereby adopts the GIS and Public Records fees as set forth in Attachment 5 of this resolution.


