

RESOLUTION NO. 363

A RESOLUTION OF THE WOODINVILLE CITY COUNCIL, AMENDING RESOLUTION 345, ESTABLISHING A COST OF LIVING INDEX FOR REVISED FIRE CODE PERMIT FEES FOR 2009

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to establish fees and charges for services by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has supported a bi-annual review of fees and charges to ensure that the fees and charges are appropriate for the service provided; and

WHEREAS, the costs of providing Fire Code permits have risen; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 345 did not set forth the cost-of-living index for determining fees for 2009;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Section 3 of Resolution 345 which previously read: "*Effective January 1, 2009, the Woodinville City Council hereby adopts the Woodinville Fire and Life Safety District Annual International Fire Code Permit fees as set forth in Attachments 2 & 3 of this resolution for use, administration and enforcing the International Fire Code established by Ordinance No. 444, using a cost-of-living adjustment as defined in the resolution, for determining fees to be effective on January 1, 2009.*"

is hereby amended to read as follows:

Effective January 1, 2009, the Woodinville City Council hereby adopts the Woodinville Fire and Life Safety District Annual International Fire Code Permit fees as set forth in Attachments 2 & 3 of this resolution for use, administration and enforcing the International Fire Code established by Ordinance No. 444, using the Seattle/Tacoma/Bremerton CPI-U, for the twelve month period of July 2007 through June 2008 to be effective on January 1, 2009.


