

RESOLUTION NO. 368

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE,
WASHINGTON, DECLARING CERTAIN ITEMS AS SURPLUS AND
PROVIDING FOR THE DISPOSITION OF THEM.**

WHEREAS, the City from time to time has assets that become surplus to its needs; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has the responsibility to dispose of property pursuant to Section 35A.11.010 RCW; and

WHEREAS, the City Council must assure that these responsibilities are carried out in the public interest by the City;


**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE,
WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Assets attached as Exhibit A are hereby declared surplus.

Section 2. The assets described in Exhibit A will be disposed of by public auction or internet auction. In the event that some or all of the assets are not sold, the City shall have the right to sell for scrap value or dispose of in such a manner to either receive some value, or pay as little as possible for their disposition.


