

RESOLUTION NO. 382

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON ADOPTING COLLECTIVE POSITIONS ON NORTSHORE SCHOOL DISTRICT PROPOSITIONS 1, 2, AND 3 THAT ARE INCLUDED ON THE FEBRUARY 9, 2010 ELECTION BALLOT.

WHEREAS, Northshore School District has three Propositions included on the February 9, 2010 Ballot, with the following official Ballot Numbers and Titles:

Proposition No. 1 – Northshore School District Renewal Education Operations Support Levy;
Proposition No. 2 – Northshore School District Renewal Capital Projects (Technology) Levy;
Proposition No. 3 – Northshore School District General Obligation Bonds - \$149,200,000

WHEREAS, the City Council directed that this matter be placed on its Meeting Agenda in compliance with restrictions established by RCW 42.17.130; and

WHEREAS, on January 19, 2010, the City Council provided equal opportunity for proponents and opponents of these measures to express views in support and in opposition of these ballot measures; and

WHEREAS, as provided in RCW 42.17.130, the City Council of the City of Woodinville may take a collective position on these matters.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Woodinville City Council hereby takes the following collective positions on the Northshore School District Ballot Measures included on the February 9, 2010 Ballot:

Proposition No. 1: In Support

Proposition No. 2: In Support

Proposition No. 3: In Support


