

RESOLUTION NO. 417

A RESOLUTION OF THE WOODINVILLE CITY COUNCIL DESIGNATING THE CITY'S SUMMER CONCERTS PROGRAM A SPECIAL CIVIC EVENT AND ENDORSING THE SALE AND/OR CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL IN CITY PARKS DURING SUMMER CONCERTS PROGRAMS.

WHEREAS, Woodinville Municipal Code Section 8.12 defines and establishes specific conditions and exemptions for Special Civic Events, as designated by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has directed staff to organize a City-sponsored Woodinville Summer Concerts event in coordination with the Greater Woodinville Chamber of Commerce and the Woodinville Wine Country Association at Woodinville's Wilmot Gateway Park; and

WHEREAS, the event will provide economic benefit to the City by drawing tourists to Woodinville; and

WHEREAS, Woodinville Municipal Code 12.50.290 prohibits the use or possession of any alcoholic beverages in a City park except by organized groups which have secured approval from the City Manager, the Director of Parks and Recreation and appropriate licensing from the State of Washington; and

WHEREAS, the City Council endorses the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages at a City-sponsored Summer Concerts event at Wilmot Gateway Park, in cooperation with the Greater Woodinville Chamber of Commerce and the Woodinville Wine County Association,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Woodinville City Council designates the Woodinville Summer Concerts as a "Special Civic Event" according to the definition provided in WMC Section 8.12.020 (3), and endorses the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages for the Woodinville Summer Concerts event at Woodinville's Wilmot Gateway Park under the authority granted to the City Manager by WMC Section 12.50.290.
