

**RESOLUTION NO. 457**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE WOODINVILLE CITY COUNCIL REGARDING THE PROPOSED 2014 KING COUNTY COUNTYWIDE PLANNING POLICY AMENDMENT UNDER ORDINANCE 17861.**

**WHEREAS**, RCW 36.70A.110 requires counties to regularly update its Countywide Planning Policies, and King County is updating these policies and has forwarded proposed amendments to all cities within the County for ratification; and

**WHEREAS**, cities that do not respond to such proposed Countywide Planning Amendments by December 7, 2014 shall be seen as being in concurrence with the proposed amendment identified as Motions 14-1, 14-2 and 14-3; and

**WHEREAS**, Woodinville continues to be classified as a Large City within the proposed Amendments which unreasonably allocates excessive growth to Woodinville with little reasonable expectation that regional funding for necessary infrastructure will be provided; and

**WHEREAS**, recent amendments by the GMPC to approve the transfer of the Klahanie Potential Annexation Area from the City of Issaquah to the City of Sammamish was approved by motion 14-1; and

**WHEREAS**, recent amendments by the GMPC to approve a technical correction to CPP DP-17 to allow expansions of the Urban Growth Area for Four-One projects was approved by motion 14-2; and

**WHEREAS**, recent amendments by the GMPC to approve the Rainier Ridge Four-to-One proposal, which would add fourteen acres to the Urban Growth area in exchange for the dedication of fifty-six acres as permanent open space, and adds the new urban portion of the Potential Annexation Area for the City of Maple Valley;

**NOW, THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The City of Woodinville continues to object to its "Large City" designation and requests reclassification to "Small City" which better reflects its status, vision, and profile.

Section 2. The City of Woodinville supports the transfer of the Klahanie Potential Annexation Area from the City of Issaquah to the City of Sammamish.

Section 3. The City of Woodinville supports the technical correction to CPP DP-17 to allow expansions of the Urban Growth Area for Four-to-One projects.


