

RESOLUTION NO. 465

A RESOLUTION OF THE WOODINVILLE CITY COUNCIL, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PROVIDE NOTICE TO KING COUNTY DISTRICT COURT OF THE CITY'S INTENT TO TERMINATE THE EXISTING AGREEMENT FOR COURT SERVICES AT THE END OF THE SECOND TERM ON DECEMBER 31, 2016.

WHEREAS, the City of Woodinville (City) is required by RCW Title 3 to provide municipal court services for judicial enforcement of local ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the City may choose alternative municipal court services that provide cost effective, transparent and manageable court service options; and

WHEREAS, the City is a party to an existing Interlocal Agreement with King County District Court (KCDC) to provide municipal court services to the City; and

WHEREAS, the current Interlocal Agreement is terminable by either party without cause and if such party provides written notice to the other party no later than 18 months prior to the expiration of the current term of the Agreement on December 31, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the deadline to provide notification of termination for the current term of the Interlocal Agreement is June 30, 2015 and the City desires to give KCDC advance notice of its intent to terminate the Interlocal Agreement provided the City enters into an Interlocal Agreement with the City of Kirkland to provide the City with municipal court services prior to June 30, 2015;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized and directed to take actions necessary to provide notification to KCDC of the City's intent to terminate the existing agreement with KCDC services on December 31, 2016 subject to Section 3 below.

Section 2. The City Manager is further directed and authorized to negotiate an interlocal agreement with the City of Kirkland for the provision of municipal court services to City beginning January 1, 2017; PROVIDED, the negotiated agreement will be subject to City Council approval prior to the June 30, 2015 contractual deadline to give KCDC notice of the City's termination of the existing Interlocal Agreement.


Section 3. The City's notice of intent to terminate the Agreement with KCDC shall be withdrawn if prior to June 30, 2015 the City is unable to execute an Interlocal Agreement with the City of Kirkland for municipal court services. Absent the withdrawal of the notice of intent prior to June 30, 2015, the City's notice of intent shall be the City's final notice of termination to KCDC as provided for in Section 1.2 of the existing Interlocal Agreement with KCDC.
