

RESOLUTION NO. 469

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO DESIGNATE AN EMPLOYEE TO ACT AS CITY MANAGER DURING THE ABSENCE OF THE CITY MANAGER OR UNTIL AN INTERIM CITY MANAGER IS PROVIDED TO THE CITY BY THE PROTHMAN COMPANY.

WHEREAS, the City Manager Richard A. Leahy is unavailable to perform the duties of his position; and

WHEREAS, the Council has authorized the Mayor to enter into an agreement with the Prothman Company to provide an Interim City Manager until a replacement for Mr. Leahy is hired; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the proper functioning of the City that an immediate appointment of an interim acting city manager be made until either Mr. Leahy is available or the interim city manager is provided by the Prothman Company,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. That the City Council authorizes the Mayor, on behalf of the City of Woodinville, to designate a current management employee to act as an Interim City Manager, until either Mr. Leahy is available to perform the duties of City Manager or until the Prothman Company provides the City with an Interim City Manager.
