

RESOLUTION NO. 482

A RESOLUTION OF THE WOODINVILLE CITY COUNCIL CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF MICHAEL J. LAMBO AS MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGE.

WHEREAS, Chapter 2.42 of the Woodinville Municipal Code establishes the Woodinville Municipal Court pursuant to Chapter 3.50 RCW; and

WHEREAS, on June 25, 2015, the City entered into an interlocal agreement with the City of Kirkland for the provision of municipal court services and facilities commencing January 1, 2017; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to such agreement, the City must appoint the current Kirkland Municipal Court judge as judge of the Woodinville Municipal Court; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has appointment Michael J. Lambo, the current Kirkland Municipal Court judge, as judge of the Woodinville Municipal Court effective January 1, 2017; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 3.50.040 and WMC 2.42.130, the appointment of the municipal court judge must be confirmed by Council;

NOW, THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:


