Regarding the proposed Brickyard Ridge Subdivision, file PPA13002/SEP13019

In response to the proposed project, we are ABSOLUTELY against this project. We are currently undergoing a daily and lengthy torture experiment perpetrated by the current development going on, which we were never notified was going to even happen, that is 40 feet away from our home. To add yet more construction, right on top of us is unbelievable. Our home, and other homes up here on 185<sup>th</sup> and 151<sup>st</sup>, are being shaken daily by the HEAVY machinery that is operating mere feet from our house, our windows are rattling every single day, walls vibrating, dishes clinking in the closed cupboards, pictures on the walls shaking. Any FURTHER construction is just going to extend the unreasonable noise, rattling and heavy vibrations, construction workers driving up and down our street all day long, invasion of privacy, CIGARETTE BUTTS near the side of the site, blocking of our exits and entrances to our own street/neighborhood that has been going on. The gigantic stump grinder machine that was placed and used just a few short feet from all of our homes registered a 78 on the OSHA approved decibel meter we measured the noise with, in our front doorway, that went on for almost a week. ANY new construction is just going to cause MORE use of that hideously loud machine. ANY new construction is just going to cause 4 more ACRES of 60-80 foot trees to be clearcut, totally destroyed, and the forest that was there, and the part that is left, provide a buffer for our entire neighborhood from noisy and traffic ridden, Woodinville Duvall road, not to mention help stabilize the hill. Every day the construction dumptrucks, concrete mixers, and all other trucks turn around all day long under our bedroom windows. ANY further construction would just cause this to continue even longer. There is incessant loud beeping from these machines as they back up and around the corner of our house all day, starting sometimes before 7 am in the morning. The dust clouds raised by the current construction (and any proposed construction) are and would be huge and filthy, and this is summer, when we want to open windows for fresh air, but there are enormous dust clouds nearby. ANY further construction would just cause more of this. Also, the concrete trucks are up here working until 11:40 P.M., that is way past the cutoff time, as well as the crew that came out SUNDAY JULY 21<sup>ST</sup>, and worked for 2 hours from 1-3 pm. In the afternoon, on a SUNDAY. Any further construction would just extend these VIOLATIONS even longer. People actually live in this neighborhood, in case the City of Woodinville has forgotten, and we have not had a decent night of sleep Mon-Fri in almost 2 months due to the construction, which if MORE construction happens, will just make it drag out even longer. Not to mention the benefit of leaving the trees alone, they clean our air and provide shade for the hill in general, now we are all subject to less cooling because of the hot, dusty, noisy construction that we don't want more of. Previously we

had believed, apparently in error, that Woodinville was a city that believed in leaving some trees as buffers and to provide privacy. It is unreasonable to expect the over 40 homes currently here in close proximity to put up with these levels of noise and disturbance, for YEARS, according to typical development/construction timelines and then try to add EVEN more CONSTRUCTION on to what is already happening. It is really unbearable to live up here right now because of the construction going on, and ANY FURTHER CONSTRUCTION would just extend the unliveability of our neighborhood.
