

# VICINITY MAP






# Sammamish Bridge and Road Project (SR 202)


SR 202, Mile Post 0.31 to Mile Post 0.56

# Plan View




Note: All Construction is above/beyond Ordinary High Water

2. King County Trail will not be impacted permanently by project
3. All work is above ordinary high water

## ROADWAY SECTION C – SR 202

STA 14+75.73 TO STA 16+14.61

## IDENTIFIED IMPACTS:

- Wetland A – Buffer is impacted
- Shading of River by new, widen, bridge

## Proposed Mitigation:

Under bridges – Remove invasive species, re-plant with native plants

Establish and Plant 0.28 acre mitigation area along north side of Little Bear Creek, just east of 134<sup>th</sup> Ave. NE

Both areas subject to on-going monitoring and maintenance after project is completed (5 years min.)

Approval of the Shoreline Permit for the Sammamish River Bridge Widening Project including the 18 conditions listed in the Staff Report
