

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

(3:30-4:45pm) Tuesday, February 16, 2016

After parking just east of the fire hydrant/"Little Bear Creek Channel Improvements" sign, I walked the site, took photos (comments included on jpeg/pdf), inspected area south of crossing (gravel parking lot), north (easement, Red Barn, concrete block wall), along creek, and up to SR 202 – following the temporary water main site layout.

**Comments:** Extremely steep slope from north end/Red Barn/Dairy Queen downhill towards creek. Abandoned easement is relatively flat (does not slope directly towards creek N-S but does drop east to west) clear of vegetation but moderately damaged due to surrounding trees and lack of maintenance.

Creek: fast moving flow – east to west - not a rain event/relatively dry conditions

Discussed project with Tom H (02/17/16):

**Notes:**

Focus on area around creek. Erosion control measures – silt fence (simple/safe approach)

Logistics of temporary water main construction – a crane will set a 40 foot steel beam/40 plus feet of HDPE on top of ecology blocks – spanning across creek. The waterway will not be impacted by this action.

\*\*\*Focus on tree removal and replacement.

Tom stated that cedars, alders, Douglas-firs, etc. tend to grow too large and are not good candidates for small spaces/urban development.

A better option would be smaller or medium sized conifers or maples – provide shade without the potential of outgrowing available area.

**Elaboration of erosion control measures:**

\*\*\* "...no significant trees or shrubs will be removed...Grass will be disturbed during construction but area will be reseeded after temporary bypass is removed." –SEPA checklist (#4b Plants)

Alder, Douglas-fir, red cedar, and pine are currently found on this site.


**Temporary water main installation** – keep excavation for ecology blocks to a minimum for relatively level creek crossing... stretch tarp across creek during steel beam and HDPE installation to prevent materials from entering creek... erosion control fence and straw wattles along top of bank (both sides) during installation... grass seed patch near ecology blocks/creek... silt fence will be installed in between creek and excavation sites for ecology blocks – restricting silt and coarse materials from entering waterway.

**Temporary water main removal** – proper usage of silt fence, straw wattles... removal of knotweed, dispose of materials - replace with native plants, reseed disturbed soils.
