Std #: .1 - 4.6(10) Title: Driveways

Description of deviation: Allow driveways with less than 125 feet of seperation between the intersection and driveway.

Need (Why): Due to the size and configuration of the site, plus the presence of an existing wetland, access to most of the lots must be taken

directly from the two streets bordering the site. Development of the site, at the density consistent with the zone, provides lots of a size which makes

125 feet of seperation from the intersection unwieldy. The stop sign on 132nd Ave NE slows traffic to approximately 15 mph, hence access to lots 3 &

4 is safe with the seperation shown, and all other lots meet the code requirements for intersection seperation.


