

# *City of Woodinville*

## Parks Rules

All City of Woodinville parks are open to the general public from dawn to dusk.

The City does not take reservations for any of its facilities other than the Woodinville Sport Fields.

Please abide by the following rules:

- All City of Woodinville parks are tobacco-free
- It is unlawful for audio equipment to be operated at a volume so as to be audible greater than 50 feet from the source.
- Dogs must be on a leash and under control at all times.
- Please pick up after your dog, and deposit waste in appropriate receptacles.
- Fires are only allowed in self-contained stoves or barbeques.
- Motorized vehicles are allowed in designated parking areas only.
- All garbage must be disposed of in approved receptacles.
- If canopies or tents are used, they must be weighed down, not staked. For tents larger than 400 sq. ft., please contact the City's Permit Center to determine if your desired use is allowed.
- There may be no use of fireworks, firearms or explosives.
- Possession or use of alcohol or drugs is prohibited.
- No overnight camping is allowed.
- No soliciting of any kind is allowed.
- No unauthorized sale of merchandise, food or services is allowed.
- No activities may take place that may endanger other users, such as golf, baseball and archery.
- Park property or vegetation may not be removed or destroyed.
