WHERE CAN I FIND MORE INFORMATION?

Temporary sign code requirements can be found in WMC 21.35.130. Temporary sign permit applications can be found online at www.ci.woodinville.wa.us and are issued over-the-counter as long as the application meets code.

Portable signs that are not permitted or not in compliance with City of Woodinville Municipal Code are subject to removal or civil infractions. Contact Development Services at 425-489-2754 or planning@ci.woodinville.wa.us for more information.

PERMIT REQUIRED

A temporary sign permit is required for all portable (a-frame) signs in the City of Woodinville. Businesses in commercial zones are only permitted one portable sign per business. Two portable signs are permitted per business in the Industrial zone.

LOCATION

The portable sign must be located either on-premises or adjacent to the property line where the business is located. Signs may be placed in the public right-of-way, but not within a street or sidewalk. Signs cannot block the sight distance for vehicles entering or exiting driveways or streets.

SIZE

All portable signs are limited to a maximum of six square feet in size. Signs may not be more than three feet in height including any toppers or handles. Signs may have no more than two sign faces.

DURATION OF DISPLAY

Portable signs may only be displayed during the hours of operation of the establishment. It is the responsibility of the sign owner to remove the sign when the establishment is not open to the public.

OTHER

Signs cannot be illuminated. No landscaping may be damaged or modified to accommodate portable signs.
