

Modification Permit for Dispensers/Piping (Any Alteration Where Fuel is Dispensed) IFC Permit Application Requirements

Fees: The fees listed are valid through December 31, 2017. The next fee adjustment will be effective January 1, 2018.

Permit Fee.....\$418

The following information is required to be submitted along with the City of Woodinville IFC Permit application for modification/alteration of equipment and tanks at fuel dispensing stations. **Application must be complete.**

A mechanical permit is also required from the City of Woodinville.

Any electrical changes will require a L & I Electrical permit.

The shaded area indicates the minimal information required for permit application acceptance by the City of Woodinville Permit Center. Final approval of permit will require that all information be provided, as applicable.

3 sets of plans and cut sheets are required.

- 3 sets of plans showing the location of property lines, buildings and building openings, roads and parking lots, aboveground and underground tanks, piping, valves, fittings and related equipment.
- 3 sets of manufacturer's product literature, "cut sheets", for equipment being used.
- L & I Contractors' License (notarized).
- Contractor's proof of certification by IFCI or other acceptable certification, Name and License Number.
- Vehicle protection design
- Hazardous vapor control plan
