Re: 2013 Street Repaving Project

Construction work will soon begin in your area. The City of Woodinville awarded a construction contract to Lakeside Industries, Inc., of Monroe, Washington to repave the following:

140th Avenue NE (from 350 feet south of NE 171st Street to 300 feet north of NE 181st Place)

NE 181st Place (from 140th Avenue NE to 142nd Avenue NE)

Work is expected to begin in mid-August 2013 and be completed by the end of October 2013 (see reverse side of this letter for a map showing the planned work area).

Construction activities will occur **Monday through Friday**, with the majority of work being performed at night **between 8:00pm to 6:00am**, along with day work for minor items. There is also the possibility of some weekend work. Every effort will be made to minimize the impact of construction activities by providing adequate advance notice and trying to construct the project quickly. However, there may be occurrences of unannounced delays lasting up to 20 minutes. Please allow extra time for your travels during the construction of this project.

In addition to paving the streets, we will replace wheel chair ramps, adjust utilities to new pavement grade, and install pavement markings. While we can only make improvements or repairs to public property, if you are aware of a problem area in the project vicinity that you would like us to look at, please contact us by August 23rd. If we are able, we will fix the problem as part of the current project or we will try to include it with a future project.

The contractor will post "No Parking" signs along the roadway within the planned construction zone three (3) days prior to start of work. Please move all vehicles off the roadway and shoulders; this will help avoid project delays. Vehicles left in the construction area will be towed. Residents are advised to be aware that hazards exist in and near a construction site, involving heavy construction equipment and dump trucks entering and exiting the project area.
